

- (1) We use glass for shelves in feature units and for fitting into glass framed doors as well as mirrors. When glass shelves are fitted we use a spring fixing clip to firmly retain the shelf. If for any reason the shelf is removed or repositioned please ensure that it is securely re-fitted into the retaining clips/shelf support. It is important to avoid overloading glass shelves. Normally all that is needed to keep glass doors and mirrors clean, is a clean dry cloth.
  
- (2) A ceramic hot plate almost asks to be taken care of. It looks so good when fitted into the work surface! Please bear in mind that it can scratch, therefore it is important to use the correct utensils, preferably pans with a "Flat" base. When cleaning the hotplate you should take care to use the recommended cleaning products. This will help to ensure that the hob always looks good. When cooking food which contains starch such as potatoes and sugar you should avoid any liquid being allowed to burn onto the ceramic surface. Wipe off any spillages as soon as possible to avoid any potential pitting of the surface due to the reaction of starch being burnt on.
  
- (3) Use of vitreous enamel in the kitchen offers good clean looks and colour too. But, please remember enamel is a surface coating and can be scratched or if hit with something sharp it can be chipped. The top surface is porous and can be stained if such as foodstuff or tea stains are allowed to remain on its surface. Cleaning often and having respect for enamel also taking care in its use are the only real ways to protect it.
